# **Heathrow Engineering Insights Privacy Notice**

This privacy notice tells you what to expect when Heathrow Airport Ltd (Heathrow) collects personal information about you when you submit the Heathrow Engineering Insights Week application form. Heathrow is committed to protecting your personal information when you apply for work experience.

Whenever you provide such information we are legally obliged to use your information in line with all applicable laws concerning the protection of personal data, including the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR).

## What information will we collect about you?

When you complete the Heathrow Engineering Insights Week application form, we will collect the following information about you:

- Name
- E-mail address
- Telephone number
- Gender
- Date of birth
- Educational establishment
- Borough of residence
- Accessibility requirements
- Allergies

## How will Heathrow use the information it collects about me?

Heathrow will use your personal data for several purposes including the following:

- To process applications for the Heathrow Engineering Insights Week
- To communicate outcomes of applications
- To monitor the diversity of applicants
- To ensure the Heathrow Engineering Insights Week can adjust to accessibility requirements and/or allergies, if required

The lawful justification for collecting and using your personal data is consent. To the extent that we are processing any health data regarding your accessibility requirements or allergies, we are relying on your express consent to do so. # How long will Heathrow keep my information?

If your application is unsuccessful, your data will be deleted after a period of one month. If successful, your information will be retained for a period of one year from the date of your application, after which point it will be deleted.

Your information will be retained in a secure environment and access to it will be restricted according to the 'need to know' principle.

We will not transfer or disclose your personal information, other than as identified in this Privacy Notice, to our trusted third party suppliers, to the police, tribunals, courts, regulators, or other authorities to assist them with their investigations or requests or for us to report security incidents or suspected or actual unlawful acts and/or as may be otherwise required by law.

## What rights do I have over my personal data?

Under UK GDPR, you have the right to:

- Access your personal data by making a subject access request
- Rectification, erasure or restriction of your information where this is justified
- Object to the processing of your information where this is justified
